Subject : Recruitment to the posts of Senior Resident/ Senior Demonstrator for the tenure period (3 years) as per Govt. of India's Residency Scheme for the session July, 2015 at the AIIMS, New Delhi.

In continuation of notice issued vide file of even number dated 24.06.2015 for recruitment to the post of Senior Resident/ Demonstrator for the tenure period (3 years) as per Govt. of India's Residency Scheme for the session July, 2015, it is informed that point no. (d) is added under heading of upper age limit (as on 31.07.2015) mentioned at para 3 of the Notice as under.

For appointment to the posts of Senior Resident/ Demonstrator, the ex-servicemen and Commissioned Officers including ECOs/SSCOs who have rendered at least five years military service and have been released on completion of assignment (including those assignments is due to be completed within six months) otherwise than by way of dismissal or discharge on account of misconduct or inefficiency, or on account of physical disability attributable to military service or on invalidment shall be allowed maximum relaxation of five years in the upper age-limit. The relaxation in upper age-limit is not available to serving Commissioned Officers.

The ECOs/SSCOs who have completed their initial period of assignment of five years of Military Service and whose assignment has been extended beyond five years and in whose case the Ministry of Defence issues certificates that they will be released within three months on selection and from the date of receipt of offer of appointment, would be permitted to appear in the competitive examinations to be conducted by AIIMS, New Delhi for posts.

The other terms and conditions will remain same.
